It could be, however, God is calling you to be the solution. Your work has been successful this year and you are well able to help someone in need of a solution.

Whether supplier or recipient none of them realised fully that the baby himself was God's ultimate solution to a difficult situation when no one on earth knew how it was going to be solved.

Here is a relevant reading for the Dec. 17 Wake Up Call Matt. 1: 1-12

After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi[I] from the east came to Jerusalem

and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star in the east[2] and have come to worship him."

When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him.

When he had called together all the people's chief priests and teachers of the law, he asked them where the Christ[3] was to be born.

"In Bethlehem in Judea," they replied, "for this is what the prophet has written:
