This email continues our six-month series looking at the Sermon on the Mount from a workplace angle:

You will be a very unusual person if you never made any enemies at work at all. No matter how you behave, how naturally likeable you are someone may well take a dislike to you - be jealous or even wish you harm.

Bible Reading

If you are a more controversial figure or an agent of change you will provoke even more hostility just by doing your job. As you read you may now be aware of those who you would call enemies or even antagonists or those with whom you have fallen out. The most natural thing in the world is to dislike or react negatively to them. Strangely, good friends can become enemies and although they once liked each other there is now enmity between them. So whether you like, loath, dislike or distance yourself from someone you may run the risk of hating them.

Jesus wants a different approach. He wants you to love your enemies. This is not affection or warm feelings, nor even friendship. This is a Christian love which cannot see below be found anywhere else but is a gift from the Master. Once He has poured this agape into your soul you can learn to love your enemy. It is deliberate and concerted goodwill which chooses to want the best for the person we would naturally want destroyed. It is a strong, challenging love which would even stand up to the individual but also be motivated by their interest. It is a specific mindset which refuses to become bitter and even prays for the other rather than sets out to annihilate. It is the same approach that God takes with us and is a reflection of His perfection.

If you want to be a perfectionist, as God is, then love, don't belittle your enemies. It's hard, it's revolutionary, it's a narrow path and few even find the gate. (Matthew 5:43-48)
