WEEK SEVEN: Spirituality and Security in Work and Life

WORDS FOR THE WEEK: "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit" (Luke 23:46)

**TAKE THIS PATH:** From Longing to Finding

**BUILD ON THIS:** Daily Presencing

FEAST ON THIS: You don't need to ask God to be with you today, that is a superfluous prayer; He is already there and will never leave you. What may help you is to ask God to enable you to stay aware of His presence. This was called *practicing the presence of God* by a monk called Brother Lawrence. Peter called it being conscious of God (1 Peter 2:19). Here are some tips to help you: choose to pray for the conversation when you dial a phone number; choose to pray for the conversation when your phone rings. Remember your forgiveness when you press the delete button. Pray for wisdom whenever you go through a door. Become conscious of breathing in the Spirit when you breathe and are tense. These practices connect what you already do with your awareness of the Father and will transform your days – every day – if you presence Him in your actions.

DQ: What ordinary action that you do today can be used to remind you of God?
